Code of Conduct

Last Revision November 20th, 2022

The Club expects that all members abide by certain acceptable standards of behavior when at the Club, as well as when representing the Club at outside functions.

The following Member Code of Conduct has been adopted by the Board of Directors and shall be strictly enforced.

Club Members are expected to:

- 1) Conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively upon them individually and the whole of the Club.
- 2) Respect and uphold the Club's history, culture and good standing in the community.
- 3) Refrain from behavior that is likely to endanger the welfare, interest, good name or character of the Club or any member
- 4) Be familiar with and abide by rules and regulations as published, including the Club's By-Laws, clubhouse rules, and golf rules and to respect the Club's property and facilities.
- 5) Abide by the USGA and local rules of golf in all golf competitions. This includes maintaining a legitimate USGA handicap index. Two basic premises underlie the USGA Handicap System; namely, that each player will try to make the best score at every hole in every round, regardless of where the round is played, and that the player shall post every acceptable round for peer review. The player is responsible for adhering to these premises.
- 6) Display good sportsmanship and gentlemanly conduct in all golf events, both on and off the course, whether at our course or any other facility.
 - a) Sportsmanlike conduct includes, but is not limited to, showing respect and consideration in language and behavior toward all who are in attendance at an athletic event.
 - b) Unsportsmanlike conduct includes, but is not limited to, inappropriate behavior in language, gesture, or action that demeans, physically intimidates or endangers others, not just during competition but also during other activities of the Club.
 - c) Good sportsmanship also implies winning with character and losing with dignity, both with class.
- 7) Conduct themselves appropriately, mindful that their behavior shall not interfere with Club staff, other members or their guest's enjoyment of the Club.
- 8) Refrain from the use of profanity, obnoxious and abusive language, rude or boisterous behavior and harassment, sexual or otherwise.
- 9) Take any issues with Club staff to the proper committee. No member may take it upon himself to discipline, ridicule, harass, embarrass or threaten any member of the staff.
- Respect and observe decisions, results and other determinations of the Board of Governors, all official Club committees and staff.
- 11) Limit excessive alcohol consumption. The staff has been instructed to follow Connecticut State laws and not serve any minor, intoxicated or inebriated person, or anyone who appears to be intoxicated or inebriated.
- 12) Address all complaints to the proper committee or the Board of Directors and not directly to the general membership.

The Board of Directors believes that violations of this Member Code of Conduct or the Club's rules and regulations could materially diminish the reputation of our Club. Any member who violates this Member Code of Conduct or the Club's rules and regulations will be subject to disciplinary action.

Green Woods Country Club Policies and Procedures (2023)

The following is a brief synopsis of some of the rules of Green Woods Country Club. For further clarification see the Green Woods Constitution in Pro Shop.

1. <u>Dress Code Policy</u>

APPROPRIATE CLUB Attire Members and guests must wear proper golf attire: collared shirts (for men), Bermuda length shorts or pants, NO cut-offs, or denims on the course, putting green or driving range.

Denims are allowed only in the clubhouse.

No tank tops or muscle shirts allowed in clubhouse Soft Spike Facility

2. Check-In Policy

Members must check in at the Pro Shop before starting play. This practice can ensure an enjoyable pace of play and will assist club personnel in locating members in the case of a family emergency.

Starting play at other than the 1st tee without approval of the Pro Shop staff is prohibited and may result in removal from the course.

3. Courteous Policy

Groups starting play on the 1st tee must alternate with groups making the turn on the 10^{th} tee.

Singles, twosomes, and threesomes should not expect foursomes ahead to permit them to play through. Reasonable judgment should be exercised with consideration of the number of groups on the course. Singles, twosomes, and threesomes should always make a foursome when permissible.

4. <u>Tee Time Policy</u>

Tee time reservations are mandatory on weekends and holidays and may be reserved with the Pro Shop staff by telephone or in person.

Be on time. Arrive at the first tee 5 minutes in advance of your scheduled tee time. Failure to check in at the Pro Shop at least 15 minutes prior to a scheduled tee time may result in forfeiture of the reserved starting time. In that event, play would be at the discretion of the professional staff, and you may be put at the end of the starting times.

5. Tournament Policy

Members may only sign-up for tournaments (entry fees apply).

Tournament sign-up sheets will be available 30 days prior to each event. Reservations may be made by telephone or in person. It is suggested that the entry fee be paid at the time of a sign-up to avoid delays on the day of the event.

Tournament participation is limited to the first 72 members that sign up. When an event is filled, a list of alternates will be maintained.

6. Cancellation Policy

Members must cancel at least three days prior to the event. Members canceling within three days are responsible for payment of the entry fee unless a replacement is located.

Members who on more than one occasion during a season sign up for an event and fail to appear on the day of the event, may forfeit eligibility to participate in any remaining events that year. It is the player's responsibility to inform Pro Shop of any changes.

Do not assume a tournament is cancelled due to inclement weather and fail to attend. Always check with the Pro Shop.

7. Golf Cart Rules

Persons possessing a valid driving license may only operate carts. Do not allow minors to drive a cart. No more than two people on any cart at any time. Observe the course rules when in effect and keep carts 30 feet away from all tees and greens.

8. Clubhouse Rules

Persons under age 21 are not permitted to sit at the bar. Any member or guest may be cutoff from purchasing alcoholic beverages at any time as deemed necessary by the bartender. No smoking is permitted inside of the clubhouse at any time.

9. Local Rules

PROVISIONAL BALL- To avoid creating unnecessary delay if a dispute or issue arises during play, the object ball and an alternative ball should be played on that hole until such time as a ruling from the Head Golf Professional can be obtained.

Procedure for Relief Situations- Players may take relief without penalty (nearest point of relief, plus one club length, no nearer to the hole) from the following:

INTERNAL OB STAKES- Out of bounds stakes between holes #1 & #2 (which pertain to the 2nd hole only), while playing hole #1. OB stakes must remain in place if interfered with while playing hole #2.

FLOWER BEDS- Ornamental flowers located in the middle of the cart turnaround by the 3rd green, and along the putting green are free relief. (Follow procedure above.)

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTION- Snack shack located behind the 7th green deemed free relief. (Follow procedure above.)

- The fencing behind #4 green bot h wood and metal handrail. (Follow procedure above.)
- The perimeter fencing along #2 and #3 will be deemed free relief under Rule 24 immovable obstruction. (Follow procedure above.)

For detail list of all the rules check with the Pro Shop staff.

10. Handicap Policy

Members must post all completed 9-hole rounds and 18-hole rounds within a reasonable time following play.

11. Driving Range Policy

You must check in with the Pro Shop staff before going to the driving range tee. Use of personal shag bags is prohibited, and range balls must not be removed from range area. Practice shall be played within the specified designated areas ONLY.

Green Woods Country Clubs Pace of Play

Pace of Play is of utmost importance to Membership, for the enjoyment of the Golf Course and the Golf experience. A general rule of thumb is to try and keep your pace of play under 2 hours for 9 holes and 4 hours for 18 holes. Helpful hints are not taking two much time to look for a lost ball, always be ready to hit your shot when it is your turn to play and do not take to much time around the green once you have completed playing the hole. Courteous golf is fun golf for everyone!

Golf's New Rules: Major Changes

New Rule: Rule 5.6 encourages prompt pace of play by recommending that:

- Players should recognize that their pace of play affects others and they <u>should play promptly throughout the round</u> (such as by preparing in advance for each stroke and moving promptly between strokes and in going to the next tee),
- A player <u>should make a stroke in no more than 40 seconds</u> (and usually in less time) after the player is able to play without interference or distraction, and
- Committees should adopt a Pace of Play Policy (rather than only say they may do so).

In addition, Rule 6.4 expressly allows playing out of turn in match play by agreement, and for stroke play, affirmatively allows and <u>encourages players to play out of turn in a safe and responsible way to save time or for convenience</u> (also known as <u>"ready golf"</u>).

Reasons for Change:

By giving players affirmative guidance, support and encouragement on prompt play, these Rule changes help in:

- Setting expectations for both beginners and experienced players on what types of behavior are considered prompt play, including the maximum amount of time it should normally take to make a stroke, and
- Encouraging players to play faster by confirming that it is proper to play out
 of turn in stroke play when it is safe and responsible to do so (that is, to play
 "ready golf").

Green Woods County Club has Pro-shop Staff and Course Rangers monitoring Pace of Play for "All" golfers' benefit. We hope everyone enjoys their golf time on our course and we look forward to seeing you soon!

POSTING YOUR SCORE

- · Post scores from home and away courses.
- Post scores in all forms of play; match play, stroke play, even team competitions in which you are requested to pick up.
- Post your score when you play at least 13 holes out of 18 holes or at least 7 out of 9 holes. On the holes you didn't play, record a par plus any handicap strokes you would have received.
- Post a score if you play two nines even if it's the same nine, or nines from different days. Simply combine the nines into an 18-hole score. Add each nine-hole Course Rating™ together and average the Slope Rating.[®]
- Post scores played in an area observing an active season even when your home club is in an inactive season.

Do Not Post These Scores

- If you played fewer than 7 holes.
- When you play in a competition limiting the types of clubs used, such as a one-club or irons-only tournament.
- When an 18-hole course is less than 3,000 yards. When a majority of the holes aren't played under the Rules of Golf, as in a "scramble."
- Do not post scores made in an area observing an inactive season.
